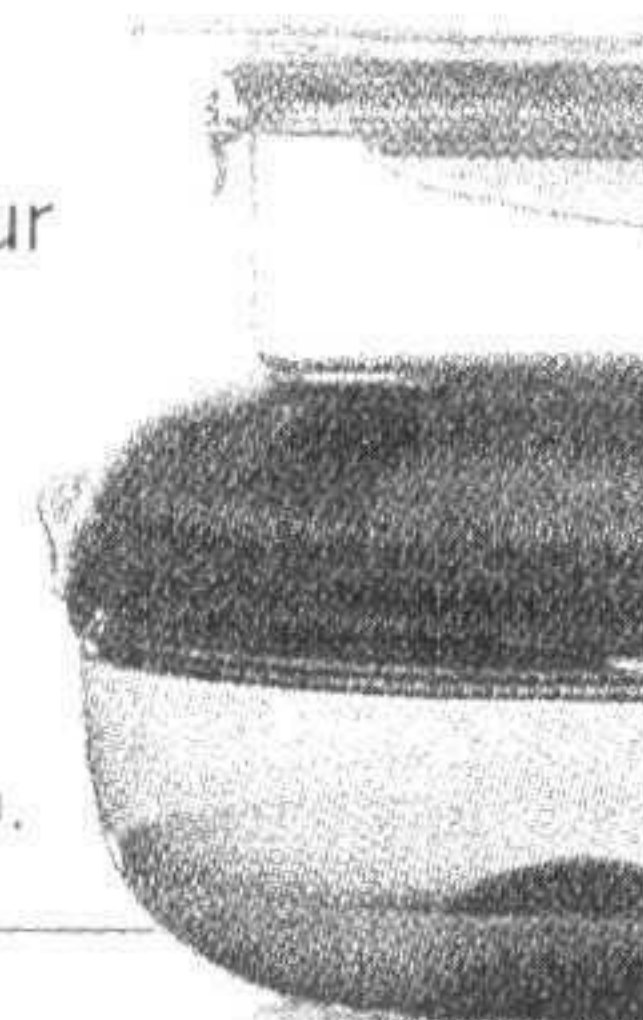
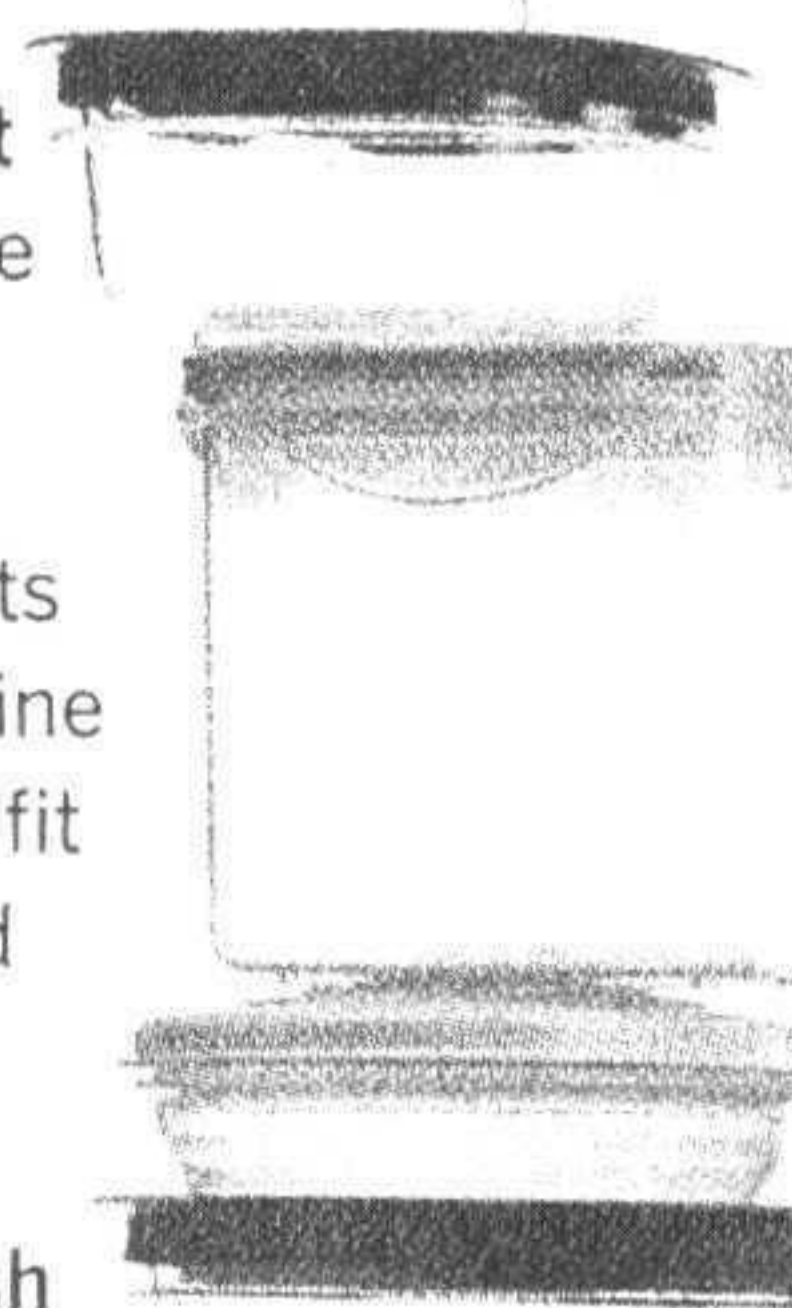

LEFTOVERS THAT LAST

Turkey, stuffing and gravy are even better the day after Thanksgiving. To be safe, get everything into the fridge within two hours of eating, says Kathy Bernard of the USDA meat and poultry hotline. Fruit pies with no dairy can stay out but may get moldy. After four days, use, freeze or toss. New products we like, which go straight from fridge to microwave:
